

Golden Gate Bridge/ Battery East Bay Trail



May 27, 2012 marks the 75th anniversary of the Golden Gate Bridge. To improve the Bridge's southeast side visitor area for this major milestone, several construction projects are underway through May 2012.

These projects include:

- Installation of lanes for bicyclists and pedestrians and improved trail grade for accessibility
- Creation of a formal view point for the Bridge and Fort Point
- Construction of the new Golden Gate Pavilion in the plaza
- Renovation of the historic Round House, formerly the gift shop, into a new meeting place for visitor programs and tours
- Revitalize the landscaping, exhibits and signage in the plaza



Battery East Road and the west sidewalk of the Golden Gate Bridge is completely closed to the public. Please see the detour map for access information.
